The City of Lovejoy provides the following list for the purpose of utilizing potential funds from the 2027 SPLOST. This list is compiled from citizen feedback at public meetings, staff recommendations, and discussions with the Mayor and City Council. The list has been divided into three primary categories: *Infrastructure*, *Public Safety*, and *Recreation*.

Projected Revenue: \$11,783,231

Infrastructure \$7,659,101 65%

- 1. **Government Building:** Expenses related to the construction, acquisition, purchasing, design, beautification, and equipping new government facility.
- 2. **Sidewalk projects:** Installation of new city sidewalks, maintenance and improvements to existing city sidewalks.
- 3. **Intersection improvements:** Drainage, striping, signage, roads, crosswalks, pedestrian movements for enhanced safety
- 4. **Utility improvements:** Installation of new utilities including water, sewer, storm drains, etc.
- 5. **Road improvements:** road widening, curbing, shoulder improvements, striping, signage, drainage, etc.
- 6. Roadways: Patching, milling, resurfacing, asphalt overlay, striping of existing roadways
- 7. Acquisition: Right of Way Acquisition
- 8. **Drainage improvements and maintenance:** storm drainpipe systems, storm drain structures, etc.

Public Safety \$2,356,646 20%

- 1. **Equipment purchases:** Vehicle purchases, training equipment, radio & purchases, communications improvements, and other equipment purchases
- 2. **IT Upgrades:** Includes IT Infrastructure new, cloud storage and other related systems, maintenance and upgrades, software upgrades, computer and related equipment purchases and upgrades, telephone lines and other communication infrastructure, and other necessary upgrades
- 3. **Maintenance and building upgrades:** building, design, beautification, grounds maintenance and improvements for existing, expansion and new facilities

- 1. **Multipurpose facility:** Expenses related to the construction, acquisition, purchasing, design, beautification, and equipping existing and new recreational facilities.
- 2. **Upkeep:** Maintenance, purchasing, upgrades, renovations, beautification, landscaping, building upgrades to existing structures and facilities.
- 3. Land acquisition: land acquisition for recreational facilities.
